SCHOLARSHIPS

Please read the instructions for each application carefully and be aware that the deadlines are firm.

The **Matt Selsor Memorial Scholarship** is available to students who are new to the Academy in grades 1 through 8 and is for the first year only. The scholarship amount is not stated because the total award may be divided between several families. New students/families are encouraged to apply and return the enclosed materials to the Marinette Catholic Central Foundation by May 1, 2014.

The **Knights of Columbus Scholarship** is for incoming Freshmen. The total scholarship amount is \$500 and may be divided between two recipients. It is open to all Freshmen whether they are new to the Academy or not. Please submit the application to the High School Office by May 15th, 2014.

The **Steve Matty Scholarship** is awarded to one incoming Senior and one incoming Junior in the amount of \$2500 each, applied towards tuition. Please complete the essay and return to the High School Office no later than April 18th, 2014. Selected recipients will be notified prior to the start of the 2013-2014 school year.

The **Dorothy Wendel Foley Scholarship** targets young women who are rising 8th grade students and encourages pursuit and enjoyment of music/journalism/language in conjunction with academic accomplishment and extra curricular interests. The scholarship is awarded to one recipient and equals 50% of tuition and fees for 2012-2014. Please complete all parts of the application and submit to the Marinette Catholic Central Foundation by May 1st, 2014.

The **Marge Bruemmer Scholarship** is open to students who have been at the Academy for more than one year and will be in grades 9 through 12. Some of the criteria taken into consideration are that the student should maintain high academic standards according to their ability, participate in school organizations or athletics, be a member of an area Catholic parish, and have a desire to attend college. The student is asked to submit a one page essay with their application. Please submit to the High School Office by May 15th, 2014.
